
### **Medical Suite**

Directly next door to Harbor Gardens sits The Drew Mathieson Center, which contains a Horticulture classroom,










as well as a learning and retail greenhouse that grows seasonal plants, such as hydroponic tomatoes and herbs, orchids, poinsettias,




hibiscus, and hydrangeas.

Free, on-street parking is available on Metropolitan Street and surrounding streets.




### 1850 Metropolitan Street

The library is open before, during, and after classroom hours for students to utilize resources, complete research, and work on assignments.








The second floor of 1815 Metropolitan houses classrooms and








the Medical Assistant Lab with simulated patients, prosthetic arms used for teaching blood draw technique, and other instruments essential to patient care.

and leads into the kitchen areas of our Culinary Arts program.












Behind the kitchen is located the Culinary Arts Ampitheatre classroom.
